PERMITTED ACTIVITY: To occupy public street rights-of-way as described below for intermittent traffic control (ITC) in conjunction with a Kawasaki commercial shoot sponsored by Fuse Interactive.

Permittee must contract with the Milwaukee Police Department to provide officers to perform the ITC. Traffic will be restricted one location at a time for periods not to exceed 7 minutes.

July 11th - 5:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. ("Temporary No Parking" and ITC)

- North 19th Street from West Michigan Street to West Clybourn Street;
- West Clybourn Street from North 18th Street to North 20th Street.

July 11th and July 14th - 5:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. (ITC)

- Intersection of North Avenue, Ivanhoe Place and North Farwell Avenue;
- East North Avenue from North Murray Avenue to East Prospect Avenue;
- North Farwell Avenue from East North Avenue to East Thomas Avenue;
- East Ivanhoe Place from North Prospect Avenue to East North Avenue;
- West/East Wells Street from North 2nd Street to North Water Street;
- North Plankinton Avenue from West Wells Street to West Wisconsin Avenue;
- West/East Wisconsin Avenue from North 4th Street to North Milwaukee;
- North Water Street from East Wells Street to East Erie Street;
- East Chicago Street from North Jackson Street to North Water Street;
- North/South 6th Street from West Canal Street to West Florida Street.

14 parking signs will be installed by Monday, July 10th no later than 2:00 p.m. Equipment will be removed (during working hours) after permit expiration. If not delivered, please call (414) 286-3329 or (414) 286-CITY (2489) before 2:30 p.m.

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This permit is issued in accordance with provisions of Ordinance No. 105-55.5 and should be displayed at the site during the effective period. This ordinance provides for certain penalties in the event of non-compliance with the conditions of the permit. Penalties can include a fine of \$500.

This permit is granted on condition that the Permittee will obey all the sections of Chapter 115 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and all specifications, rules, and regulations of the Department of Public Works pertaining to this permit.

BARRICADING & SIGNING: Any person doing work in the Public Way shall comply with City of Milwaukee D.P.W. Manual Traffic Control for Construction & Maintenance Work and Part VI of the State of Wis. "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices".

OCCUPYING STREET: Materials occupying street shall be kept at least two feet away from any tree, alarm box, manhole, or catch basin. Materials and equipment shall be kept at least ten feet away from fire hydrants, fifteen feet away from crosswalks and in accordance with other restrictions of the code of Ordinance.

REVOCATION OF PERMIT: The Commissioner of Public Works reserves the right to revoke this permit at any time, if in his judgment; it is in the best interest of the City of Milwaukee.

GUARANTEE: The permittee guarantees that he shall reimburse the City of Milwaukee for all damages to any city property resulting from his work operations and to hold the City of Milwaukee harmless in case of any accident or an account of any damages arising through the issuance of this permit, regardless of whether such damage or accident is done by himself, his agents, employees or sub-contractors.

NO DISCRIMINATION: During the use of the public area, the sponsoring organization will not exclude any person from participation in, deny anyone the benefits of, or otherwise subject anyone to discrimination because of race, color, national origin or handicap.

THE ACCEPTANCE OF THIS PERMIT BY THE PERMITTEE CONSTITUTES AN ACKNOWLEDGMENT AND ACCEPTANCE OF THE CONDITIONS AND REGULATIONS HEREIN NOTED.

OCCUPANCY

MAINTAIN PEDESTRIAN TRAFFIC: A minimum 5 ft. Pedestrian access must be maintained at all times, either on city sidewalk or by a temporary pedestrian walkway. A fence or railing, if required by the Commissioner, of at least 3'6" high shall be erected on both sides of the temporary walkway. If the entire sidewalk is to be closed, proper warning signs shall be provided, as directed by the Commissioner.

If a structure to be erected or wrecked is more than twenty feet in height above the sidewalk or less than ten feet away, proper protection of the general public, and public and private property, shall conform to City Specifications.
